Fitness Centre

- Waiting for a bill for the flooring for the gym, likely around \$3500
- Sanitization bills are starting to add up, about \$300 per month
- Averaging about 25 people through the gym in a week
- Volunteer to-do list has been added to the website
- Hoping some more people will step up to volunteer, there are guidelines for them to follow
- Volunteers have been amazing
- Maximum has fluctuated based on member feedback, right now it is 7 plus volunteer
- Went through the volunteer protocols
- Talk about gym hours and slots available
- Social media blast and email out to current and previous members, OHL, and minor hockey email lists
- Adding a second administrator during the week to help with adding on evening slots
- Question raised about how selection of equipment works to be removed and purchased, Jocelyn went through the process, Trevor suggested getting feedback from members about purchases moving forward
- Question of personal training is free based

Baseball Committee

- Onanole Foundation has given \$500 towards the baseball diamond, will go towards having soft sand on hand
- Final phase of the ball diamond will be the outfield, aeration and seeding of the outfield is being looked at
- An estimate of the aeration and seeding has been sought after from Darren Beatty for \$5722
- An estimate of the irrigation system \$9639 including taxes from D & B
- Scott has been working on a grant to hopefully get money to put towards this
